REVISOR DISTRIBUTION COMPOSE AND CUSTOMIZATION TOOL

Revisor enables users to very easily create and customize their own Linux distribution (media) from Fedora and its derivative Linux distributions. The software is in Fedora since Fedora 7, when it was the primary eye-catcher of all features in that release. For smooth deployment, Revisor integrates with the Cobbler provisioning framework. Jeroen is the lead developer for Revisor.

FEDORA UNITY PROJECT

As one of the system administrators for the Fedora Unity project, with over 75.000 hits per 3000 unique visitors a day, Jeroen is responsible for maintaining the DNS and mail infrastructure as well as Cachefu enabled Plone instances on a Zope and Fedora Directory Server backend using a Varnish/Apache balancing setup.

For any given Fedora release, Fedora Unity releases two or three so-called Re-Spins, media created to reflect a number of updates released since General Availability of said release. These Re-Spins are created with the use of Revisor. Jeroen is responsible for creating and distributing these Re-Spins as well as performing the necessary Quality Assurance.

ANACONDA

Anaconda is the program that performs the installation of Fedora as well as derivative distributions. Having said that, this important component is maintained by Jeroen for stable Fedora releases since the Fedora 7 era. This enables downstream consumers of Fedora.

COBBLER

Jeroen is the author and mentor of the workshop named "*Deploying Linux*", as well as updates Cobbler to reflect distribution changes in (amongst others) Fedora. Jeroen is also involved with the efforts to integrate Windows provisioning into Cobbler.

PUPPET

As the maintainer of the EL-4, EL-5, and all current Fedora branches including Rawhide, for all of the packages related to Puppet, one of the contributors to Puppet Common Modules, the owner of puppetmanaged.org, and the author of the workshop named "*Puppet - Configuration Management made easy*", Jeroen easily qualifies as a Configuration Management specialist

Red Hat Emerging Technologies project for System Provisioning in Cloud Computing environments. Although a Red Hat project, Jeroen packaged all Ruby packages related to this project (just in time for public announcement), and still maintains said packages.
